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C 02/17/01/12-5 DONATION OF PORTION OF A VACANT LAND TO ENDUMENI MUNICIPALITY: REMAINDER OF ERF 1418, GLENCOE: Mr NJ HARTUNG (7/3/2/4/31;1418/R NGL)

RESOLVED

- 1. It being noted that Erf 1418, Glencoe had been subdivided into Portions 1, 2 and the Remainder thereof in 1976, and that clause 10 of the Conditions of Establishment issued under PTB 14859 had required that a road servitude in favour of the erstwhile Glencoe Municipality be registered over the Remainder thereof;
- 2. It further be noted that the original owner of Erf 1418, Glencoe, being a Mr N J Hartung, has in the early 1980's disposed of all the properties, except for the Remainder thereof, and that the required road servitude had never been registered in compliance with the Conditions of Establishment;
- 3. It be noted that the registered owner of the Remainder of Erf 1418, Glencoe, Mr N J Hartung, has, in a letter dated 7 December 2011, offered to donate the property to the Endumeni Municipality, on condition that the Municipality accepts liability for the transfer costs, which should be in the region of R5200.00;
- 4. It being noted that the acceptance of the donation can be viewed as a rectification of a matter that should have been attended to by the erstwhile Glencoe Municipality and transferring attorneys during the early 1980's, and may also be seen as an appropriate method of obtaining land that may be used to promote road safety in the interest of the community and visitors to the area, as the said property, being 8m² in extent, is supposed to be utilised as a splayed corner at the intersections of Biggar Street North and Seder Avenue, Glencoe, being an intersection at a main arterial route through the town;
- 5. In view of the above, the donation of the said Remainder of Erf 1418, Glencoe, in extent 8m², with a municipal value of R1000.00, by the current registered owner thereof Mr N J Hartung as per Title Deed No T 11947/1974, be accepted, and that the Council accepts liability for the costs involved in obtaining ownership of the property;

6. The Acting Municipal Manager be authorised to sign any documents incidental to effecting the donation, and transfer of ownership of the property into the name of the Endumeni Municipality.

It be noted that, in pursuance of an earlier resolution of the Council in terms of Section 78 of the Municipal Systems Act No 32 of 2000, a public consultation process was undertaken by means of notices in the local newspaper calling upon the general public to comment on the Council's intention to explore the possibility of providing such service through an external mechanism, and that at the closing date of 15 December 2011, only one comment thereon was received, to whit from the Dundee Farmers' Association who had supported the Council hereon;
- 4. In view of the fact that all initial indications are that the Municipality does not have the capacity, skills, resources; finances and knowledge to provide the service of a pound through its internal structures, it formally resolves and determines that such service be provided by means of an external service provider upon vacant Council land known as a portion of the Remainder of Erf 384, Dundee;
- 5. The necessary public notices be placed in local and provincial newspapers calling upon experienced and knowledgeable service providers to submit their bids for the operation of the pound in terms of the requirements of the Kwazulu-Natal Pounds Act No 3 of 2006;
- 6. The necessary public notices be placed in local and provincial newspapers calling upon experienced and knowledgeable service providers to submit their

bids for the construction of the required infrastructure to establish a pound;

- 7. It be made a requirement of the agreement to be entered into between the Municipality and the service provider:
 - that only local labour shall be employed to assist with the daily operation of the pound;
 - that the service provider shall operate the pound at its own cost, expense and for their own account;
 - the Endumeni Municipality shall only provide the infrastructure for the rendering of such service;
 - the service provider shall be responsible for any required maintenance to the infrastructure to be provided following normal wear and tear thereto;
 - the Endumeni Municipality shall not contribute any further finances towards the daily operation costs or other expenditure associated with the operation of the pound;
- 8. A proposed service level agreement, to be entered into between the Endumeni Municipality and the successful service provider, be prepared and submitted to the Council for approval.
